





EXPECTED PROGRAMME RESULTS


PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION

- All Development Regions in Greece are eligible for funding
- **Grant rate**: in line with the provisions of the <u>applicable State Aid Regulations</u> (General Block Exemption Regulation GBER)
- Selection of projects open calls and competition as follows:
 - **One Individual Grant Scheme** (three focus areas):
 - Green Industry Innovation
 - Blue Growth
 - Information and Communication Technology (ICT)

Two Small Grant Schemes

- 1 Green Industry Innovation/ Blue Growth/ ICT (for SMEs)
- 2 Initiatives for development of business skills (for enterprises, clusters etc.)







BILATERAL FUND

- Total budget Euro 150,000;
- Unique opportunity for bilateral project cooperation (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway);
 Not mandatory, but encouraged;
 Access to expertise and solutions from Donor State entities.


Travel Support – Open Call available


Budget: Euro 50,000

Lump sum: Euro 1,000 - 1,200 - 1,500 per entity







Deadline for submission of applications: 1 October 2019






Individual Project Scheme

Eligible Project Promoters

- ✓ SMEs and large enterprises with no more than 25% public ownership, registered as legal persons in Greece
- ✓ At least 3 years of operation at the date of the deadline

Eligible Partners

- Any private or public entity, commercial or noncommercial, registered as legal person in one of the Donor States or Greece
- Main activity closely linked to the expertise in which its contribution is proposed






Small Grant Scheme for SMEs

Eligible Project Promoters

- ✓ Small and Medium Sized Enterprises (SMEs) registered as legal persons in Greece
- ✓ At least 1 year of operation at the date of the deadline.

Eligible Partners

- Any private or public entity, commercial or noncommercial, registered as legal person in one of the Donor States or in Greece
- Main activity closely linked to the activities in which its contribution is proposed.





Minimum and maximum grant amounts


Individual Project Scheme

- ✓ Minimum amount of grant applied for: Euro 200,000
- ✓ Maximum amount of grant applied for: Euro 1,500,000

Small Grants Scheme for SMEs

- Minimum amount of grant applied for: Euro 50,000
- Maximum amount of grant applied for: Euro 200,000

Grant rates in line with State Aid Regulations (approx. 50 per cent grant for SMEs) Co-financing from applicant in the form of cash (equity, bank loan)






Eligible activities (1)

Focus area: Green Industry Innovation

- Development, implementation and investment in innovative environmental friendly technologies;
- Development of green products and services;
- Development and implementation of "greener production processes"

Note: All economic sectors can be supported – green element mandatory

- reduction of the environmental footprint of the Greek enterprise






Eligible activities (2)

Focus area: Blue Growth

- >Innovative marine equipment;
- > Development of supra structures (ship repair);
- >Green shipping technology, including electrification of ships and ferries;
- > Digitalisation in shipping;
- > Maritime and marine safety; Marine cyber security;
- > Solutions for LNG bunkering and distribution;
- > Coastal and maritime tourism;
- > Blue biotechnology and sea bed mining;
- > Blue Energy.





Eligible activities (3)


Focus area: Information and Communication Technology (ICT)

- Development and application of ICT solutions for industrial processes or other business operation (new-to-enterprise);
- Development of products or services for digitalisation of all economic sectors (new-to-market);

Note: Projects should be within the areas:

Automation — Information — Transformation

Eligible activities in line with GBER art. 25 (R&D&I)
