

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding («**MOU**») has been entered into between:

- (1) **HWEA** (Hellenic Wind Energy Association ELETAEN), Kosta Varnali 52 & Epidavrou str., 15233 Chalandri Athens («**HWEA**»); and
- (2) **ANEV Associazione Nazionale Energia del Vento** (Italian Wind Energy Association), (C.F. 07171931004) Lungotevere dei Mellini 44, 00193 Roma («**ANEV**»)

1 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 HWEA (Hellenic Wind Energy Association ELETAEN) is the national association for wind energy, established in 1990, which brings together around 100 corporates and 500 physical persons as members, covering -among others- the supply chain of wind energy in Greece i.e. WTGs manufacturers, investors, energy producers, operators, developers, service providers etc. as well as scientists, academians, professionals etc.
- 1.2 ANEV Associazione Nazionale Energia del Vento (Italian Wind Energy Association) – is the environmental protection association, recognized pursuant to Law no. 349 of 8 July 1986, set up in July 2002, which brings together around 120 companies and 5000 single members representing the national wind energy sector in Italy and abroad, including producers and operators of electricity and technology, plant designers, engineering and environmental studies, electrical traders and developers who operate in compliance with the Association’s rules and regulations.

2 PURPOSE

- 2.1 The aim of this MOU is closer cooperation on mutually relevant topics within the scope of sustainable & renewable energy production, related to onshore and offshore wind power production technologies.
- 2.2 The parties wish to strengthen their relations, and to promote and stimulate bilateral cooperation between the Italian and the Greek industries, research institutes and organizations.

3 SCOPE OF THE COOPERATION

- 3.1 The parties agree to share information and experience considered to be of mutual interest, and when suitable, involve the local business community and institutions in the parties’ respective regions to leverage the economic and environmental opportunities of sustainable & renewable wind energy production. This may include exchange of information and experiences on the following indicative areas:
 - promotion of new or state-of-the-art technologies and solutions within development and scaling of sustainable & renewable wind energy production in addition to new solutions,

value propositions and strategies, which may be of relevance for the other party and its members/customers,

- training, education and communication initiatives, including initiatives aimed at tackling dis/mis-information related to wind energy,
- best practices aimed at minimising the footprint of wind energy projects and maximising their positive contributions to local communities,
- development of offshore wind energy in the respective Exclusive Economic Zones (EEZs) between the two countries,
- expanding the electricity interconnections between the two countries.

3.2 The parties aim to organize meetings or events, either virtually or physically, to cover the relevant information exchange mentioned herein and develop ideas on how to further cooperate. The cooperation between the parties will be promoted via relevant media channels.

4 ETHICS

4.1 The parties acknowledge that the collaboration set out in this MOU shall be based on stringent ethical requirements, and that it does not contribute to corruption, the violation of human rights or poor working conditions, or have a harmful impact on local communities and the environment.

5 DURATION AND AMENDMENTS

5.1 This MOU shall be good for three years as of the date of its signing. The term can be subsequently extended by the prior express agreement of both parties.

5.2 Either party may terminate this MoU at any time provided that at least three months prior written notice has been given to the other party.

5.3 No amendment of this MoU shall be effective unless in writing.

6 LEGALLY NON-BINDING

6.1 None of the provisions of this MOU are intended to establish a legally binding or financial obligation on the parties or any third party.

6.2 Individual joint initiatives that are identified by the parties pursuant to this MOU are, as necessary, developed and implemented through separate legal agreements, contracts or other mechanisms.
